#### **Company Data**

Biolabs Red Services Ltd, together with its training arm Ethan Quality Management Institute, is a Ugandan-based multinational consultancy firm with collaborations in East Africa, Malawi, and South Africa. The company is legally registered to conduct business with international governments and was formally recognized by the Ministry of Health, Uganda (ADM:171/388/01) to provide Quality Assurance consulting and technical support services for medical laboratories. Its work is directly supervised by the Uganda National Health Laboratory Services/Central Public Health Laboratories (UNHLS/CPHL), ensuring alignment with national priorities.

With over 10 years of experience, Biolabs has established itself as a trusted partner in health systems strengthening, laboratory quality management, diagnostic stewardship, and antimicrobial resistance (AMR) surveillance. The firm has developed a reputation for driving accreditation readiness, quality improvement, mentorship, and implementation support, leveraging internationally recognized standards such as ISO 15189, ISO 17025, ISO 17043, ISO 17011, ISO 19011, ISO 35001, ISO 22367 and ISO 9001.

#### **Financial Management**

Biolabs Red Services has established a strong and accountable financial management system guided by approved policies, standard operating procedures, and supporting forms. The system leverages electronic platforms such as QuickBooks for records management and Beyonic-OnAfriq for petty cash administration. Anchored on Good Accounting Principles (GAAP) and International Accounting Standards (IAS), the system is fully aligned with PEPFAR compliance requirements. To date, Biolabs manages resources amounting to **USD 918,123.85** and has consistently achieved tax clearance for the past decade. The company's finances are externally audited on an annual basis by Woodhask (ICPAU Firm No. AF0357), ensuring transparency, accountability, and credibility.

#### **Human Resource Management**

Under the stewardship of the Human Resource Director, Biolabs Red Services has developed and implemented a comprehensive Human Resource Manual, currently maintained at version control level. The manual covers all aspects of staff welfare including benefits under the National Social Security Fund (NSSF), occupational health and safety provisions, sexual harassment prevention policies, and structured performance management systems.
